

From Father Michael:

An excerpt from the Homily by Pope John Paul II at Living History Farms in Des Moines, 4 October 1979:

As one who has always been close to nature, let me speak to you today about the land, the earth, and that "which earth has given and human hands have made." The land is God's gift entrusted to people from the very beginning. It is God's gift, given by a loving Creator as a means of sustaining the life which he had created. But the land is not only God's gift; it is also man's responsibility. Man, himself created from the dust of the earth was made its master. In order to bring forth fruit, the land would depend upon the genius and skillfulness, the sweat and toil of the people to whom God would entrust it. Thus the food which would sustain life on earth is willed by God to be both that "which earth has given and human hands have made."... Bring with you to Christ the products of your hands, the fruit of the land, that "which earth has given and human hands have made." At this altar these gifts will be transformed into the Eucharist of the Lord.
